Day trip to Tinit and Sermilik icefjord

We meet up at the harbor in Tasiilaq at 9 am.

After sailing approximately 2 hours we arrive at the settlement of Tiniteqilaaq, where most of the 125 inhabitants support themselves by hunting and fishing.

The settlement is situated beautifully at the Sermilik Icefjord, providing a magnificent view to the Ice cap.

During our stay in Tinit we will include a little sightseeing tour of the settlement, while the icebergs drift by in the fjord.

After the tour around Tinit we'll sail into the icefjord and go ashore at an abandoned winter settlement, where we will enjoy a delicious lunch. This will be followed by a little cruise between the large icebergs, before heading back to Tasiilaq.

We'll be back at the harbor in Tasiilaq at approx. 5 pm.





Day trip to Kuummiut

We meet at the harbor in Tasiilaq at 9 am.

We start off by heading to the Ammassalik Fjord. Depending on the time of the season, you may see whales and icebergs along the way.

Our first stop is the great glacier near Kuummiut, where we'll turn off the engine and get some refreshments. If in luck, we can see the ice falling off the glacier.

Next stop is the settlement of Kuummiut, where we go ashore. After a tour of the village, dinner will be served at the house of the local man Boas – a rare opportunity to dine in local style.

The dinner will consist of local products caught in the area around Kuummiut, deliciously served ...

After dinner we walk to a nearby mountain peak, from where we'll have a spectacular view over the village and the nearby fjords. Afterwards we'll go down to the boat and head back to Tasiilaq. We will arrive back at the harbor in Tasiilaq at approximately 5 pm.

Day trip to the Knud Rasmussen Glacier

Pick up at the harbor in Tasiilaq at 9 am.

We set off towards the Ammassalik fjord where you, depending on the time of the year, may see whales and icebergs along the way.



The first stop will be the Ikateq base. Depending on the tide we'll go ashore at Ikateq at this point or we'll do it on the way back. At the Ikateq base you can see many old trucks and the old, yet intact, runway.

These are the remains from the American presences in Greenland from 1942 to 1948.

After the stop in Ikateq, we continue, by boat, up to the Knud Rasmussen Glacier, where we go ashore and enjoy a nice lunch.

There will be time to wander around in the area.

We will be back at the harbor in Tasiilaq at approximately 5 pm.

Day trip to the Sermilik Ice Fjord - Ikateq and the Harn Glacier



We set off from the harbor in Tasiilaq at 9 am.

After an hour of sailing we arrive at the mouth of the Sermilik fjord. Here we will go to the abandoned settlement, Ikateq, on a small island. You will be able to go ashore at the village. In the village one can still see the school, the church and of course the beautiful view into the Sermilik fjord.

We sail further into the Sermilik fjord and into Johan Pedersen fjord. From here you can see the ice rise from the inlet.

Going ashore at the Harn Glacier we'll enjoy lunch overlooking the front of glacier. There will be time to hike to the ice and have a look around.

After about 2 hours we sail back to Tasiilaq arriving at the harbor at approx. 5 pm.

Half day trip Kulusuk, Aputsiaq and Tasiilaq

Transportation from Kulusuk to Tasiilaq with stops along the way. You will be picked up at the harbor in Kulusuk after having completed the short journey of approximately 20 minutes walk from the airport in Kulusuk on foot.

We sail towards Apusiaq glacier in a relaxed pace, and after approx. half an hour's cruise we will stop in front of the glacier. There will be served hot coffee and tea.

When all have taken the pictures that they want, we sail through Tunu towards Umivik and then we head for the largest town in East Greenland, Tasiilaq.

There will be opportunity to see whales in the area, though this cannot be guaranteed. In the East Greenlandic waters you can see Humpback whales, Fin whales and Minked whales (Herring beater)

The trip to the harbor at Tasiilaq takes approx. 3 hours depending on the weather.

The tour can also start from Tasiilaq.

Our boats

Nuna is a 6-meter boat with a 175 hp engine and a 6 hp motor for emergency help. The boat is licensed for 12 people.

It is a good boat to sail different tasks as it can carry up to 1300kg.



Nivi is a 6 m boat with a 150 hp engine and a 6 hp engine helps the boat is licensed for 12 people, and like NUNA a good boat for day trips and other tasks.



BUI is a Viknes 770 built in 2009, is approved for 8 people.

The boat has a toilet and heated by an oil burner. The boat can be covered, so you can enjoy the ride in all weathers.
